

Enric Granados i Campiña (Lleida 1867 – English Channel 1916). Composer and pianist.


He studied piano in Barcelona with Francesc Jurnet and Joan Baptista Pujol and, since 1883, harmony and composition with Felip Pedrell. In 1887 he went to Paris, where he studied with Charles W. de Bériot and met the Catalan pianist Ricard Viñas.

In 1901 he founded the *Acadèmia Granados*, an institution that has left an important imprint in Catalan musical life. Among many others, he collaborated with Mathieu Crickboom, Pau Casals, Jacques Thibaud, Joaquim Malats and Joan Manén.

In 1911 he premiered the first book of *Goyescas* -his masterpiece for piano- in Barcelona, and the second book at the Salle Pleyel of París in 1914.

He died on his journey back from New York when a German U-boat torpedoed the ship where he travelled on. He had gone to New York with his wife to attend the premiere of the opera version of *Goyescas* (1916) at the Metropolitan Opera House.

Together with Albéniz, he was the creator of the Catalan modern piano school.
