

Robert Gerhard

2020 has been designated Gerhard Year by the Generalitat de Catalunya to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the composer's death.

Born in Valls in 1896, Robert Gerhard i Ottenwaelder studied with Enric Granados, and was pupil of Felip Pedrell, first, and Arnold Schönberg, later, who introduced him to dodecaphonic music. Afterwards, he became interested in electroacoustic and concrete music, being one of the precursors in Catalonia.

Gerhard was a teacher at the *Escola Normal* and collaborated with the Publications Committee of the Generalitat de Catalunya at the time of the Republic. Between 1934 and 1939 he was librarian of the Music Section of the *Biblioteca de Catalunya*, where he organized, together with the musicologist Higinio Anglès, the 3rd Congress of the SIM and the 14th Festival of the SIMC in Barcelona in 1936.

In 1939, to avoid possible reprisals, he remained in Paris until, with the help of friends and colleagues, he went into exile to Cambridge, where he died in 1970.
